Global impact committee

- Current level of donations for the TPP around 7.86 million \$ YTD and still increasing
- Ongoing support of UNICEF to fulfill the ELIMINATE pledge



Grants Committee

• KCF has awarded US\$374,745 via 158 grants/scholarships between October 1, 2024-April 1, 2025.

This breaks down to:

- 34 Microgrants that impacted 19,469 children
- 16 Club Grants that impacted 182,782 children
- 20 District Grants (we not track number of children impacted)
- 71 Youth Opportunities Fund grants (Key Club) (we do not track the number of children impacted)
- **11 Tomorrow Fund grants (Circle K)** (we do not track the number of children impacted)
- 2 Top Five District Scholarships
- **4 Misc grants** to Trick or Treat for UNICEF programs and individual Kiwanis club grants made possible by private donations and/or club foundations



Grants awared to European KC in 23/24 out of the TPP account Club Grants

- Kiwanis Club Mühlviertel, Austria District, US\$3,391 club grant; Raised Garden Bed, Health and Nutrition
- Kiwanis Club Gallarate, Italy-San Marino District, US\$2,600 club grant; Montessori Room Project, Health and Nutrition
- Kiwanis Club Lavanttal, Austria District, US\$5,940 club grant.

District grants

- Belgium-Luxembourg, **US\$630** for Relief for Ukrainian kids
- Switzerland-Liechtenstein, **US\$621** for Youth Camp 2024



Finance Committee

- Financial situation is ok, but recognized a small deficit due investment losses → Stock Market
- However, operating results are better than budget by 500k\$
- Operating expenses less then budgeted by 170k\$
- Total Fundraising for FYTD 3/25 = US\$1.548 Million
 - Good News: This is ahead of all prior years and FY budget

KCF Board

- Board discussed the merger from the KYP Fund into KCF Fund
 - Needs to be clarified within both boards KI and KCF
