Types of service projects

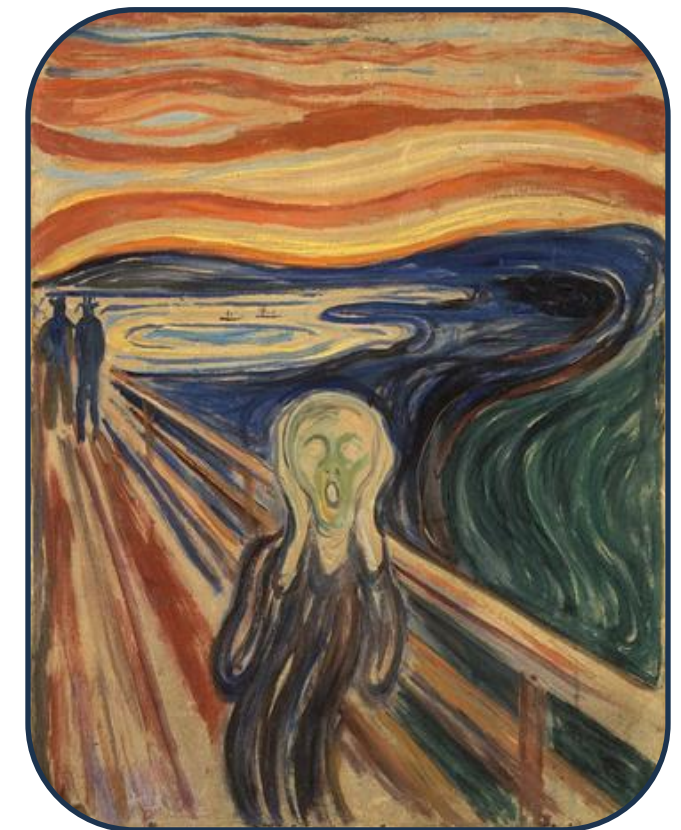
